## 6 Lessons from Acts

- God's Biggest Gamble is Jesus' Ascension when he commissions us to be his Spirit-empowered witnesses to the world.
- If we are faithful in difficult circumstances, Jesus as King can be on display
- New life is possible by God's grace through faith in Jesus
- In Jesus people with impossible differences can be held together
- Confessing Jesus as Lord is in opposition to the idolatry of the world and the idols of our own hearts
- God isn't telling you to produce results; God is asking you to be faithful.
